



SKI SAFARI IN THE ALPS



Think of the Alps, and think of skiing. The French and Italian Alps have a reputation for easy-access powder skiing and plenty of off-piste runs. Whether by helicopter, ski lift or randonnée, you'll be smiling, smiling, smiling. Locals have been skiing these "hills" for centuries, and the tradition is part of the fun.

THE EXPERIENCE

WHAT TO EXPECT

◀ HELI-SKIING

Nothing quite beats clicking in after a heli lift. The Valgrisenche valley has incredible glaciated runs. You'll be right on the Italian border. The relief is so massive your legs may scream for reprieve after your first 5,000ft descent. But once you spy your next line from the chopper, adrenaline kicks in and we bet the next run may beat the first. Ski. Repeat.

- Average run vertical – *1,000 to 2,200 meters*
- Average heli time per day – *20 minutes*
- Snow conditions – *powder*
- High point – *3,486 meters*
- Maximum of 2 heli drops per day
- Eleven provides highly-trained IFMGA certified heli-ski guides
- Complimentary use of high-end skis specially adapted for heli ski and off-piste snow conditions in the French Alps
- All avalanche safety equipment is included

◀ OFF-PISTE SKIING

Legendary off-piste runs promise endless steep and deep lines. With so much terrain, we often remind clients to leave some gas in the tank—this terrain has “best-day-ever” potential written all over it.

◀ ON-PISTE SKIING

Simply spoken, piste means ski trail. There are endless trails and ski lifts, routes, restaurants and multiple ski resort connections in the valley. The Chalet is surrounded by seven world-class ski resorts, all 30 minutes or less away. We choose the day's best conditions prior to even stepping out the front door.


